

Patient Initiated Teledermatology

How it works

GP requests images from patient. The patient is:

- Provided with basic instructions (e.g. how to take the best photos for telederm)
- Asked for relevant information
- Given a secure @nhs.net email address to send the images to

The GP receives the patient images and relevant information, uploads them to the secure Consultant Connect platform, and sends the query directly to the Dermatology team.

Using the Consultant Connect platform to securely upload and send patient image(s)

Log into your dashboard and follow the simple steps illustrated on the diagram below.
